pale pink, fresh, precise aromas of pink grapefruit, flowers and dusty minerals dry and racy on the palate		
Finca el Origen Estate, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2022	\$16	\$60
‘joven’ style with deep-set, ripe dark-berry aromas and flavors that are delivered in silky, long and fine tannins

cherry and black currant flavors, finishes with good grip and lingering dark berry notes

delicately sparkling wine is fragrant with enticing aromas of apple and peach	
Domaine Carneros, Brut Rosé, Napa, California	\$80
made from Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, yeasty flavors of raspberries, strawberries, vanilla, toast and honey	
Laurent- Perrier, Champagne Brut La Cuvee, Champagne, France	\$116
delicate nose with hints of fresh citrus and white flowers, perfect balance between freshness and delicacy with fruity flavors very present on the finish	
Veuve Cliquot Brut, Champagne, France	\$150
classic refined apple, grapefruit and dough aromas that follow through on the palate

Tomàs Cusiné, Auzells White Blend, Costers del Segre, Spain, 2021	\$50
foundation of old vine macabeo and sauvignon blanc, this blend is rounded out with decreasing proportions of chardonnay, riesling, albariño and muscatel	
Ferrari- Carano, Fumé Blanc, Sonoma, California, 2021	\$51
aromas of white peach, orange blossom, mango complemented by peach, grapefruit, pear and lemon flavors	
Conundrum, Wagner Family, White Blend, California, 2022	\$58
aromas and flavors of hard candies, flowers, and a hint of minerality	
La Casa de Las Locas, Ribeiro, Galicia, Spain 2021	\$68
aromatic, lemon yellow in color with greenish hues; citrus aromas (lime, tangerine), floral notes and herbal touches appear on the nose; the palate is fresh and well-balanced	
Trimbach Reserve, Pinot Gris Reserve, Alsace, France, 2017	\$99
dry, smoky and elegant, featuring flavors of glazed pear, chamomile, plum skin and crystallized honey	
The Crossings, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2022	\$55
lifted notes of gooseberry and passionfruit, underpinned with citrus notes; palate is full with pure fruit flavours, yet balanced with a persistent, crisp mineral finish	
Paco & Lola, Albariño, Rias Baixas D.O., Spain, 2022	\$59
green apple notes that are entwined by ripe pineapples with herbs	
Envidia Cochina, Albariño, Rias Baixas, Spain, 2022	\$71
fresh with carbonic fermentation, citric, notes of fruit in syrup, balanced acidity, structured, with long finish and persistent. Biodynamically produce	
Zarate “El Palomar”, Albariño, Rias Baixas, Spain, 2021	\$80
Well-balanced with a citric entry that attacks the palate with both exuberance and precision, leading to a simple but crisp lime and green apple finish

Château de Montfort, Vouvray Demi-Sec, France, 2020 \$63
pale green-gold color with aromas of Granny Smith apples with a hint of minerality, refreshing with great fruit and intense, lively acidity

Joseph Drouhin, Chablis, Burgundy, France, 2022 \$85
apple, pear and mint on the nose, good precision to the apple and peach flavors

Louis Jadot, Pouilly Fuisse, Burgundy, France, 2022 \$79
fruit flavors with notes of melon and minerals, gently touched with oak, ending in a fresh, silky finish

Georges Duboeuf, Pouilly Fuisse, Burgundy, France, 2022 \$96
round, fleshy, full-bodied and hearty with powerful white blossom and almond aromas and dried fruit flavors with a subtle hint of figs

Napa Cellars, Chardonnay, Napa Valley, California, 2022 \$52
meyer lemon melds with toasted coconut flakes; exhibits soft, balanced acidity and a creamy finish

Red

Cline, Pinot Noir, Sonoma Coast, California, 2020 \$59
sumptuous flavors of raspberry, lilacs, and dark chocolate, with subtle hints of vanilla and toasted oak

Crossbarn by Paul Hobbs, Pinot Noir, Sonoma Coast, California, 2019 \$93
medium to full-bodies, the palate is laden with red and black berry flavors, finishing with great freshness

Paul Hobbs, Pinot Noir, Russian River Valley, California, 2019 \$130
the silky, supple palate is brimming with raspberry, caramel fleur de sel, lavender, cardamom; all supported with a mineral backbone

Isole & Olena, Chianti Classico, Tuscany, Italy, 2020 \$67
delicate aromas of iris, violet, sour cherry, tobacco and black pepper; on the palate it is dry, very fresh and juicy, with crisp fruit, balanced tannins and a long, elegant and fruity finish

Ramon Bilbao Crianza, Rioja (Tempranillo), Spain, 2019 \$58
maroon, with the aroma of fresh, dark fruits like blackberries, and licorice with sweet tones of nutmeg

Trapiche, Terrior Series, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2018 \$74
beautiful dark, ruby Malbec, stewed plums, berries, earthy on the nose. Nicely balanced with hints of spice, earth, cigars, leather on the palate. Tannins well under control and drinking beautifully; finish is medium-long

Conundrum, Wagner Family, Red Blend, California, 2021 \$70
ripe fruit flavors and soft textures with Thai, basil, grilled steak with an accent of dried red chilis

The Prisoner, Napa, California, 2021 \$99
round and soft on the front palette, dark berries and a slight caramel taste fill your mouth and a perfect touch of acid rounds out the wine leading into the very soft and supple tannins on the finish

Bressia Conjurno, Red Blend, Tupungato, Argentina, 2003 \$164
blend of Malbec, Cabernet and Merlot grapes; raisin tobacco and other dark, jammie notes on the bouquet with plum and berry flavors and spice on the finish

Girard “Artistry”, Bordeaux Blend, Napa, California, 2019 \$125
aromas of currant, blackberry, & vanilla bean interlaced with toasted spices with strong hints of chocolate covered cherries

St. Francis, Merlot, Sonoma, California, 2018 \$57
sanguine in cranberry while offering a velvety smooth, rounded approachability, expressing a big, leathery backbone of tannin and toasted oak

Napa Cellars, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa, California, 2021 \$69
full-bodied with aromas of blackberry and plum and oak, vanilla and vibrant berry flavors

Sequoia Grove, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa, California, 2019 \$90
aromas of bright black cherry and blackberry, followed by baking spices and a hint of chocolate. Intense flavors of blackberry with round and smooth tannins, with subtle notes of toasted vanilla.

Chateau Montelena, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa, California, 2019 \$143
full-bodied and dense, with Montelena's typical power, tannin and reserved nature, this is a big, rich, formidably endowed red
