Atlas is one of New York's most notable public art displays, greeting passers-by to the 5th Avenue entrance of Rockefeller Center between 50th and 51st Streets. Designed by Lee Lawrie and Rene Chambellan in 1937, the Art Deco statue depicts the Titan from Greek mythology, Atlas, whose punishment following defeat was to carry the world on his shoulders.
